Introduction

Welcome to Trowbridge Town Council's guide to information and events aimed at helping the victims of the current war in Ukraine.

The level of public awareness of, and the engagement with, the plight of Ukrainians (whether still in Ukraine or now here in the UK) has grown almost exponentially over the last few months. We have therefore decided to review the information that this guide tries to provide and have now limited it to two key areas.... a compendium of online and physical sources of information, support or assistance to anyone interested in offering help of any kind; and a diary of local events aimed at Ukrainians arriving in the area and their hosts.

Aims and goals of this guide

The primary aim of this guide is to act as an effective “go to point” for information on how residents of Trowbridge can practically help during the current crisis in Ukraine.

We have listened to all the suggestions from local residents and have radically reviewed what is contained in this guide. We have shortened and simplified it.... keeping the parts that you told us were useful, removed everything that you said was not needed, and added a new section that you asked for.

We are therefore now concentrating on only two areas. These are:

Section 1: A compendium of links and contact details for useful sources of information and guidance,

Section 2: A diary of events being held in the Trowbridge area for Ukrainians and their hosts.

It is not our aim to become involved in any debate about the politics behind this crisis. It is however important that we categorically condemn Vladimir Putin’s actions and state that we unequivocally stand with the citizens of Ukraine, wherever they may be, as they fight to deal with this unwarranted invasion of their homeland and assault on their lives and liberty.

A further, rather more intangible, aim of this guide is to try and help build a strong community sense of support for, and empathy with, the victims of the Ukrainian war here in Trowbridge.

Ukrainians arriving in Trowbridge after fleeing the war in their homeland will need more than just accommodation. Many will arrive here feeling lost and alone in an unfamiliar land. Many will be disorientated, exhausted and in emotional distress. Many will have left loved ones behind and will be filled with despair at the prospect that they may never see them again.

Whilst we are in no way qualified to offer anything resembling professional advice on how best to help our guests cope with such profound emotional trauma.... what we can say is that we will need to be both empathic and sympathetic when dealing with people who have experienced, and escaped from, horrors that we can barely start to imagine.

At the same time, nor should we ignore the pressures on anyone offering their home, their time or their commitment in order to help another human being in crisis. No-one should be left feeling concerned that there won’t be any support available from those around them here in Trowbridge. These are our local heroes, they are our friends and neighbours and they are freely giving to help those who desperately need help. We must not be blind to their needs either.

The information in all the sections of this guide will be regularly reviewed as additional or updated information becomes available.

A lot of the information in this guide is presented as hyperlinks to documents, videos and other online resources that are on the internet. These hyperlinks are usually displayed in blue underlined text.

But..... the most important contacts you can make in our local community are..... each other.

Together, everyone who is considering joining or has already registered to join the Homes for Ukraine scheme form a ready made community of like-minded people in Trowbridge. Bringing that community together, giving you all the opportunity to ask each other questions, share your experiences, and yes..... learn from each other's mistakes..... will not only create a massive sense of "togetherness" amongst the hosts and prospective hosts in our town, but will allow us to build on our experiences and offer one of the most joined up and communicative communities of hosts anywhere in the country.

To this end, the team that brought us the Facebook Group "TROWBRIDGE HOMES FOR UKRAINE - Домівки Троубріджу для України" has set up a Whatsapp group for anyone involved in any way to join, share ideas and experiences, and build a strong local community.

Important note: There are reports of requests appearing on social media apparently from Ukrainian refugees seeking sponsors in the UK..... or from people in the UK saying they're sponsors looking for a "guest". Whilst many of these requests may well be genuine, but some may not be, and anyone considering contacting a person advertising themselves on social media as either a refugee looking for sponsorship in the UK or a sponsor looking for a guest to stay in their home should be aware of this and take all possible steps to ensure the veracity of the post. We therefore *strongly* advise that you do not disclose any personal information online until you have confirmed the identity and intentions of the person you're communicating with.

How we'll store and use your information.

When you contact us to express interest in any of the initiative under way in the Trowbridge area, we may ask you for your contact information..... your email address and a telephone number.

Depending on the nature of your interest, we may ask you whether you are willing for us share your contact information with community groups, charities, faith groups or individuals aiding and assisting in supporting Ukrainian refugees in Trowbridge and the surrounding area.

At no time will we ask for your physical address.

We will not pass your contact information onto anyone without your permission or for any commercial purpose.

You can at any time request a copy of any/all the information that we hold on you relating to your expressed interest in helping Ukrainian Refugees in Trowbridge.

Finally, you can at any time request your details are removed from our records. Once your request is received, all contact details that we hold for you will be deleted and you will stop receiving communications from us relating to either the Homes for Ukraine scheme or volunteering to help Ukrainian refugees in Trowbridge.

It will be your own responsibility to notify any other community groups that you may be in contact with and/or remove yourself from any social media groups that you may have joined.
